




# Madco

For the first time, Ambientec collaborates with designer Elisa Ossino to experiment with color, introducing a warm, emotional, yet minimalist dimension to the concept of a contemporary lantern. madco balances functionality and artistic expression, embracing a graphic quality that elevates its design to an object of visual fascination. Its luminous body, a perfectly formed sphere, appears to float effortlessly atop a sleek, 360° rotatable structure, creating dynamic and ever-changing light configurations.







This interplay of form and movement transforms madeo into more than just a light source—it becomes a sculptural centerpiece that invites interaction.


The lower cover, housing its advanced technological components and driver, is a canvas of color and texture. Available in five refined shades—Oliva (olive), Pesca(peach), Cacao (cacao), Mostarda(mustard), and Ciliegia (cherry)—these hues evoke natural warmth and sophistication while adding a graphic depth to the design. Each shade complements the minimalist geometry of madco, creating a dialogue between light, color, and material that feels fresh and contemporary.

The lantern's portability and versatility further enhance its appeal. With a high waterproof rating (IP66) and a USB type-C rechargeable battery, madco is as practical as it is elegant. Its tactile design encourages users to touch, rotate, and reposition it, inviting playful interaction. Whether gracing a terrace during an evening gathering, adding ambiance to a bedroom, or brightening a bathroom, madco seamlessly adapts to any setting.



Elisa Ossino is a Sicilian architect and designer, trained in Milan at Politecnico di Milano. In 2006, she founded Elisa Ossino Studio, specializing in residential and retail interiors, product design, art direction, and set design. Her work blends geometric abstraction, monochromes, and surrealist influences, creating a unique relationship between light, objects, and space. A key element in her style is a sense of scenic suspension, reflected in the lightness of her designs. Essential lines and geometries define her work, giving spaces a deep, scenographic quality.

Ossino's projects have been published and exhibited globally, including at the 2016 "W-Women in Italian Design" at Triennale Design Museum. She has won several awards, including the EDIDA 2020 for Balnea (Best Bathroom). In addition to her studio, she co-founded Nume, Officina Temporanea, and H+O, and teaches at IUAV University and Istituto Marangoni.
