## Product Description

The Kabin vase is inspired by the classical, simple forms found in Japanese craftsmanship. The large table vases offer the same stability and complexity as the traditional Japanese tea bowls, and the oval-shaped bodies rest on top of a small foot or pedestal, adding refinement to the classic form.

A love story between Japanese and Scandinavian craftsmanship, has resulted in this minimalist vase. Offering a fresh take on classic vase shape with a number of lamellas covering the round surface. Elegantly sculpted, the Kabin Lamella adds an organic and sculptural detail to any interior scheme.

The Kabin Vase works beautifully as a centerpiece on a dining table, sideboard, or console, where its sculptural form draws the eye even without flowers. Use it with branches or dried arrangements for a bold expression, or leave it empty as a standalone decorative object.

As it is a hand glazed nature product, the colours may vary slightly and as it is not 100% waterproof, a bag for fresh flowers is included.

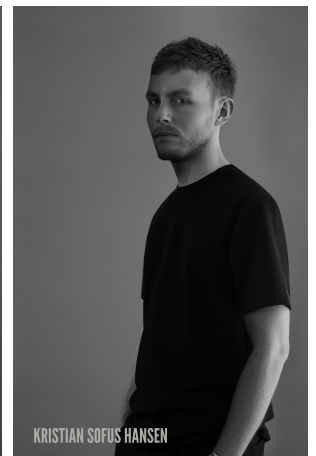
## Designer Description

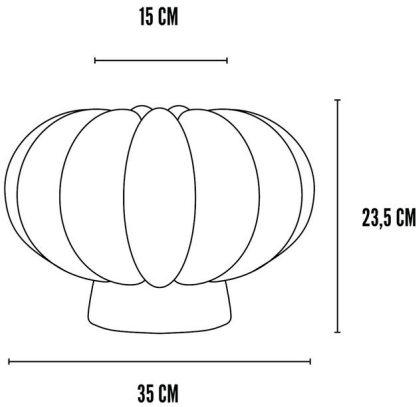

### Family Description Text

Kabin is a meeting of traditions, a quiet dialogue between Japanese craftsmanship and Scandinavian sensibility. Inspired by the timeless simplicity of classical forms, the vases rest on small pedestals like modern tea bowls, balancing refinement with an understated presence. Each piece is hand-painted, carrying the subtle traces of the artisan's touch. They are objects of stillness and harmony, where form becomes a vessel for both function and poetry.

Each edition unfolds as a unique expression of surface and character. Kabin Lamella carries a rhythm of flowing lines, its lamellas encircling the body like soft architectural folds, a sculptural gesture that gives movement to silence. Kabin Shisen reveals a world of detail, where hundreds of circles dissolve into a delicate mesh, a tactile landscape named after the Japanese word for both "mesh" and "a way of seeing." Finally, a third edition with a smooth surface pares the form back to its essence, its presence calm and refined, celebrating the quiet purity of restraint.

Together, the three editions form a collection that is at once sculptural and subtle, vessels of tradition and touch, where the meeting of cultures transforms simplicity into poetry.

### Color Description

Hand-painted in a deep, warm dark brown, this shade evokes the richness of earth and roasted beans. Its grounded elegance lends both warmth and depth, while brush stroke variations bring gentle shifts in tone and texture, making each piece entirely unique.

### Maintenance Guide Description

Our hand-painted ceramic pieces are crafted as decorative objects, designed to age gracefully when cared for with gentleness.

The outer surface of our pieces is hand-painted and should be treated with the same reverence dust lightly with a soft, dry cloth, allowing the painted character to remain untouched. Water, harsh cleaners, or abrasives should never meet this surface, as they can disturb its delicate finish.

Vases are sealed within and may hold water for fresh flowers. Clean their interiors gently with lukewarm water, then dry carefully, taking care that no moisture touches the painted exterior.

To preserve their vibrancy, keep each piece away from prolonged sunlight and sudden shifts in temperature. With such mindful care, every ceramic piece will hold its artistry, warmth, and timeless presence for years to come.

### Materials Description

Ceramic is one of the oldest and most enduring materials, celebrated for its strength, versatility, and timeless beauty. Shaped from natural clay and fired at high temperatures, it achieves a density and durability that make it ideal for both functional and decorative use. Its smooth surface provides the perfect canvas for craftsmanship.

Our ceramic is elevated through hand painting, where layers of pigment are carefully applied by skilled artisans. This process creates subtle variations in tone, texture, and detail, ensuring that no two pieces are ever alike. The result is a material that combines resilience with individuality practical enough for everyday use, yet refined enough to stand as an object of art.

Hand-painted ceramic embodies the harmony of nature, craft, and time: a surface that carries both the permanence of fired clay and the soulful presence of the human hand.
