These plant pots are thoughtfully designed with a small drainage hole at the base and a matching saucer, ensuring optimal water flow and air circulation for plants.

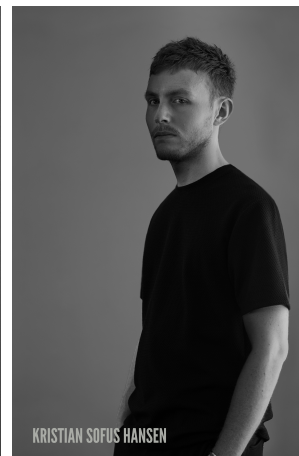
Designer Description

Together, they craft design that transcends time, poetic yet practical, expressive yet enduring.



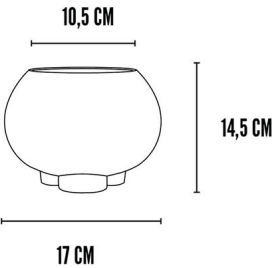

Resistant to rain, they stand gracefully through the seasons, though they are not frost-proof. In winter, we recommend bringing them indoors or protecting them with a waterproof cover to safeguard their surface from damage.

To care for the finish, dust gently with a soft, dry cloth. When deeper cleaning is needed, use a damp cloth with mild, pH-neutral soap, then dry carefully. Avoid abrasive pads, harsh chemicals, or acidic cleaners, as well as sharp objects, which may mark or disturb the painted surface.
