Perfect as a sculptural statement beside a sofa, next to a lounge chair, or framing a bed as a distinctive nightstand, it brings both function and artistry to any setting. The Artist Side Table is the perfect complement to our Toe Chair series.

Made from cast fiber concrete, the side table has a tactile stone-looking surface with small holes and colour variations. Due to the product is cast and afterwards hand painted, each product is unique.

The side table is cast in a single piece. For indoor use.

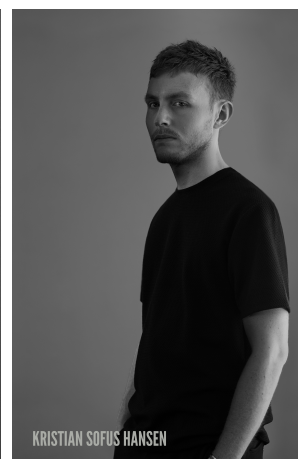
Designer Description

Together, they craft design that transcends time, poetic yet practical, expressive yet enduring.



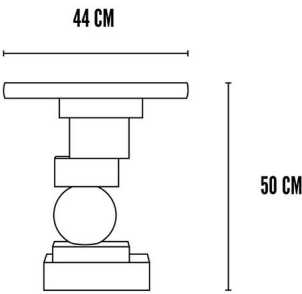

Family Description Text

Rising from the ground with quiet strength, the Artist Collection is not merely furniture but sculpture in motion. Each form is a meditation on balance and proportion, where geometry drifts into poetry and raw materials are shaped into timeless expressions of craft.

At the heart of the series, the Artist Dining Table stands as both a gathering place and a living artwork. Its base, sculpted in hand-painted fiber concrete, holds the piece with a sense of permanence and calm. Above, a wooden tabletop rests like a forest canvas, its living grain deepening in tone and meaning as the years move through it. Together they speak in harmony, one raw and elemental, the other warm and organic, their quiet dialogue unfolding through textures both enduring and expressive.

The Artist Side Tables echo this language of form and strength. In one form, they rise entirely from hand-painted fiber concrete, monolithic companions whose surfaces carry subtle variations like fingerprints of their making, each one singular and unrepeatable. In another, an oak tabletop meets a fiber concrete base, the two materials converging in a union of earth and wood, solidity and warmth. Brutalist in spirit yet softened by the human touch, they hold a presence that feels both architectural and intimately alive.

The Artist Collection is more than a series of objects. It is functional poetry that grounds interiors with quiet power and sculptural grace, inviting not only daily use but also moments of reflection and admiration.

Color Description

Hand-painted in a clean, bone white, this shade combines purity with subtle warmth. Its quiet brightness brings clarity and softness, while brush stroke variations create delicate movement, making each piece distinct and full of character.

Maintenance Guide Description

Hand-painted fiber concrete is strong and resilient, yet its artisanal finish requires thoughtful care. Dust surfaces regularly with a soft cloth, and for routine cleaning, use a damp cloth with mild, pH-neutral soap, then dry thoroughly. Avoid abrasive pads, solvents, or acidic and alkaline cleaners, as these can damage the hand-painted layer.

Always protect surfaces with coasters, mats, or felt pads to prevent scratches, stains, and heat marks. Wipe spills immediately to reduce the risk of absorption, and avoid prolonged exposure to standing water. To preserve its finish, keep furniture away from direct sunlight, high humidity, and extreme temperature changes.

With simple, mindful care, hand-painted fiber concrete furniture will maintain its unique character, depth, and elegance for years to come.

Hand-painted fiber concrete combines strength with artistry, transforming an industrial material into a refined surface for pieces that enrich the home. Reinforced with fibers for durability, it offers resilience against everyday use while remaining lightweight and versatile. Each piece is painted by hand, creating subtle variations in tone and texture that make every surface unique.

The result is a finish that balances raw honesty with crafted detail, bringing depth, character, and individuality to contemporary interiors.
