Born of durable fiber concrete, the design can be used both indoors and out, weathering seasons with grace. A gentle drainage hole, paired with a perfectly fitted saucer, nurtures the quiet rhythm of growth honouring both the plant and the space it inhabits.

With its graceful Hexa size, the design is a quiet celebration of nature's gentle rhythms. The delicate 23 cm opening cradles plants and trees with finer, more tender root systems.

For a harmonious and elegant display, combine Sunao plant pots and vases in different sizes across a windowsill, console, or patio. Grouping multiple pieces creates a layered, sculptural effect that enhances the natural beauty of each plant while adding rhythm and balance to your interior or outdoor space.

Thoughtfully designed with a small drainage hole at the base and a matching saucer, ensuring optimal water flow and air circulation for plants

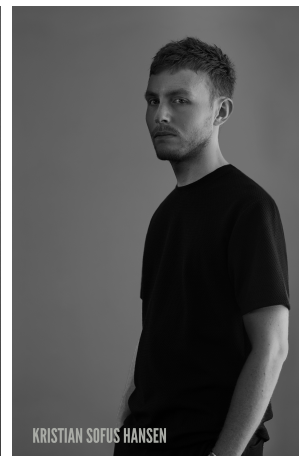
Designer Description

Together, they craft design that transcends time, poetic yet practical, expressive yet enduring.



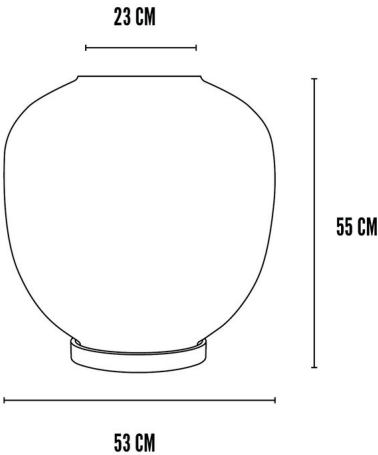

Family Description Text

In Japanese, Sunao means honesty. It is a word that holds more than truthfulness; it carries the spirit of living with clarity, humility, and respect for the natural world. The Sunao Collection is born from this philosophy, an exploration of how simple forms and honest materials can create vessels that feel both timeless and alive.

The inspiration lies in the dialogue between nature and craft. Each vase and plant pot is shaped to frame what it holds, yet never overshadows it. The smooth surface speaks of calm refinement, like the stillness of a quiet morning, while the Beehive texture, cast from shoreline shellfish, celebrates imperfection, rhythm, and the raw poetry of nature.

Every piece is hand painted, carrying subtle variations that make it one of a kind, echoing the Japanese belief that beauty is found in uniqueness and quiet detail. Just as no leaf, branch, or wave is ever identical, no Sunao vessel is the same.

Whether standing with flowers, branches, or greenery, or existing in sculptural silence, Sunao becomes more than an object. It is a companion to daily life, a reminder of honesty in design and in living, where simplicity allows nature to take centre stage.

Color Description

Hand-painted in a bright, pale natural beige with a whisper of warmth, Birch reflects the gentle tone of fresh wood. Its light and airy presence brings softness and calm, while variations in brush strokes lend natural depth, ensuring each piece is uniquely alive.

Maintenance Guide Description

Our hand-painted ceramic pieces are crafted as decorative objects, designed to age gracefully when cared for with gentleness.

The outer surface of our pieces is hand-painted and should be treated with the same reverence dust lightly with a soft, dry cloth, allowing the painted character to remain untouched. Water, harsh cleaners, or abrasives should never meet this surface, as they can disturb its delicate finish.

Vases are sealed within and may hold water for fresh flowers. Clean their interiors gently with lukewarm water, then dry carefully, taking care that no moisture touches the painted exterior.

To preserve their vibrancy, keep each piece away from prolonged sunlight and sudden shifts in temperature. With such mindful care, every ceramic piece will hold its artistry, warmth, and timeless presence for years to come.
