The square big, bone white Sphere Vase Shisen, offers a unique detailed finish, with the attempt to create a unique surface of hundreds of small circles fading into a tactile pattern. Shisen is Japanese for a "mesh" or the "way of seeing things".

The Sphere collection has become synonymous with the visual language and the signature series of 101 Copenhagen. The series is a family of unique silhouettes and textures gathering in a decorative and sculptural manner. Elegantly sculpted, each vase is finished with an intricate ornate detailing. Inspired by ancient Chinese vases, a palette of faded earth tones is characteristic of the Sphere collection which was developed in close collaboration with highly skilled ceramists, ensuring the precise contrast between the smooth shapes and sharp edges.

A striking eyecatcher for any room, place it on the kitchen countertop, a desk, side table, console, or open shelving, the Sphere Vase Bulb Shisen brings sculptural elegance to both contemporary and classic interiors. Its intricate texture and soft bone-white tone make it equally captivating displayed on its own, styled with dried stems or flowers. Together, they craft design that transcends time, poetic yet practical, expressive yet enduring.



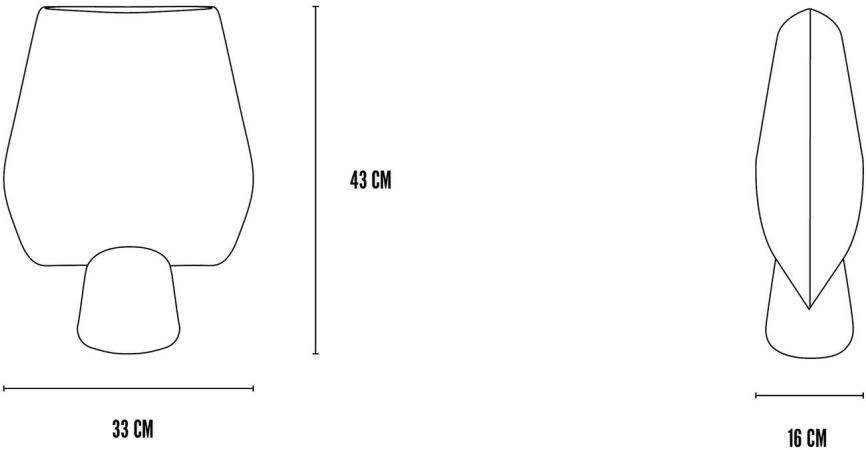

Color Description

Hand-painted in a clean, bone white, this shade combines purity with subtle warmth. Its quiet brightness brings clarity and softness, while brush stroke variations create delicate movement, making each piece distinct and full of character.

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Maintenance Guide Description

Our hand-painted ceramic pieces are crafted as decorative objects, designed to age gracefully when cared for with gentleness.

The outer surface of our pieces is hand-painted and should be treated with the same reverence dust lightly with a soft, dry cloth, allowing the painted character to remain untouched. Water, harsh cleaners, or abrasives should never meet this surface, as they can disturb its delicate finish.

Vases are sealed within and may hold water for fresh flowers. Clean their interiors gently with lukewarm water, then dry carefully, taking care that no moisture touches the painted exterior.

To preserve their vibrancy, keep each piece away from prolonged sunlight and sudden shifts in temperature. With such mindful care, every ceramic piece will hold its artistry, warmth, and timeless presence for years to come.

Materials Description

Ceramic is one of the oldest and most enduring materials, celebrated for its strength, versatility, and timeless beauty. Shaped from natural clay and fired at high temperatures, it achieves a density and durability that make it ideal for both functional and decorative use. Its smooth surface provides the perfect canvas for craftsmanship.

Our ceramic is elevated through hand painting, where layers of pigment are carefully applied by skilled artisans. This process creates subtle variations in tone, texture, and detail, ensuring that no two pieces are ever alike. The result is a material that combines resilience with individuality practical enough for everyday use, yet refined enough to stand as an object of art.
