Characterized by two sculptural legs that meet at a central point, the design creates a subtle sense of balance and tension. A small opening at the top offers space for a single branch, a few delicate stems, or a minimalist arrangement - though the vase is equally striking as a standalone art piece.

Together, they craft design that transcends time, poetic yet practical, expressive yet enduring.



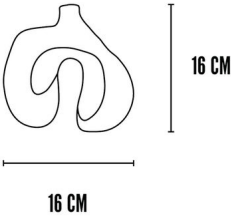

Family Description Text

Born from the Japanese word for movement, the Ni Collection is more than a series of vessels; it is a story of motion captured in stillness. Each piece begins as clay shaped by hand, transformed into a form that feels alive, as though caught mid-stride. The silhouettes are fluid and organic, reminiscent of wind sweeping across water or the graceful arc of a dancer in motion.

Resting on two sculptural legs that converge in a delicate meeting point, each form carries an almost human presence, poised, upright, and full of quiet energy. As you turn it, the shape seems to shift before your eyes, revealing new curves and tensions with each angle, as though the piece itself were subtly moving.

The narrow opening above invites quiet simplicity: a single branch, a few fragile stems, or nothing at all, allowing the work to stand as an expressive artwork in its own right.

The Ni Collection does not simply hold; it converses. It is both presence and pause, a reminder that beauty often lives in the spaces between movement and stillness.

Color Description

Hand-painted in a bright, pale natural beige with a whisper of warmth, Birch reflects the gentle tone of fresh wood. Its light and airy presence brings softness and calm, while variations in brush strokes lend natural depth, ensuring each piece is uniquely alive.

Maintenance Guide Description

Our hand-painted ceramic pieces are crafted as decorative objects, designed to age gracefully when cared for with gentleness.

The outer surface of our pieces is hand-painted and should be treated with the same reverence dust lightly with a soft, dry cloth, allowing the painted character to remain untouched. Water, harsh cleaners, or abrasives should never meet this surface, as they can disturb its delicate finish.

Vases are sealed within and may hold water for fresh flowers. Clean their interiors gently with lukewarm water, then dry carefully, taking care that no moisture touches the painted exterior.

To preserve their vibrancy, keep each piece away from prolonged sunlight and sudden shifts in temperature. With such mindful care, every ceramic piece will hold its artistry, warmth, and timeless presence for years to come.

Materials Description
