Product Description

Crown Table, Low in Caramel rises from the spirit of Brutalist architecture, where form is stripped to its essence and structure becomes poetry. The circular mouth-blown glass tabletop rests upon four cylindrical legs, a gesture both simple and monumental. The Caramel hue, a rich golden brown infused with soft amber warmth, captures light with a luminous glow, adding natural depth and quiet elegance reminiscent of polished resin and aged wood.

A breath of space between edge and base, gives the impression of a surface suspended in air. Combined with its sculptural proportions and flawless craftsmanship, the Crown Table balances gravity and lightness, creating a quiet, ethereal presence in any interior. The glass table is supported by a wooden base with internal metal reinforcement, ensuring stability while preserving aesthetic purity.

Place the Crown Table, Low in Caramel as a coffee table or statement piece in a living room, lounge, or lobby. Its warm, refined tone complements other Crown tables or can stand alone as a luminous sculptural object, adding subtle depth and elegance to modern interiors.

Due to the artisanal nature of mouth-blown glass, subtle variations and air bubbles may occur, making each table a unique, one-of-a-kind piece.

Together, they craft design that transcends time, poetic yet practical, expressive yet enduring.



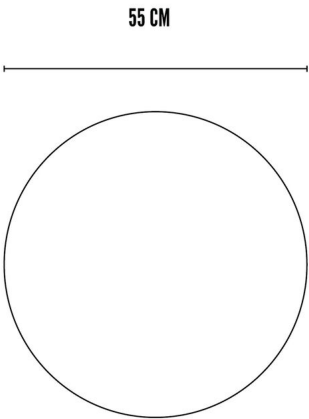
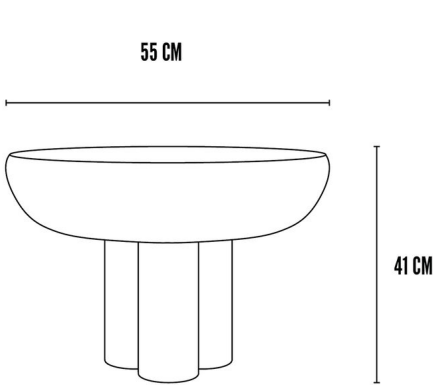

The Crown Collection rises from the spirit of Brutalist architecture, where form is stripped to its essence and structure becomes poetry. A circular tabletop rests upon four cylindrical legs, a gesture at once simple and monumental. Here, the column is no longer hidden but celebrated, standing proud as both support and symbol, a rhythm of strength translated into sculptural form.

The legs stand apart, leaving a wide breath of space between edge and base. This distance creates the illusion of a surface suspended in air, a massive weight appearing to float with quiet ease. It is in this balance between gravity and lightness that Crown finds its voice, grounded yet ethereal, austere yet refined.

The collection comes in three distinct expressions, each offering its own character and material poetry. In hand-painted fiber concrete, Crown is raw and tactile, a modern echo of cast structures that carries the subtle marks of craftsmanship. In plated iron, it takes on a darker, weighty presence, recalling the endurance of stone and the uncompromising clarity of monumental forms while refined by its metallic surface. In mouth-blown glass, it becomes luminous and ethereal, capturing light within its sculptural body and revealing the fleeting beauty of translucency.

Whether placed in a private home or a public space, Crown does not simply furnish a room but inhabits it, offering a timeless expression of simplicity, weight, and grace.

Color Description

A rich, golden brown hue infused with a soft amber warmth, Caramel radiates natural depth and quiet grace. Its tone recalls the golden resin that seeps from tree bark, catching the light like liquid caramel. Smooth and luminous, it carries the earthy richness of aged wood and the gentle glow of polished amber. Both warm and refined, Caramel brings a comforting elegance to any palette, a color that feels rooted in nature and timeless in spirit.

Maintenance Guide Description

Though delicate in appearance, the glass is strong and durable, designed for everyday use in decorative and functional objects. To maintain its pristine look, we recommend regular cleaning with a soft microfiber cloth and a gentle glass cleaner or diluted soap solution. Spray the cleaner onto the cloth (not directly on the glass) and wipe in smooth, circular motions. Always dry with a clean cloth to prevent streaks or water marks. Avoid abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or acidic substances, which can dull or damage the glossy surface. For tables, use coasters or felt pads under objects to prevent scratches or thermal shock from hot items. While the glass is moisture-resistant, it's best to avoid prolonged exposure to standing water or humidity, especially for vases empty and dry them between uses to preserve the finish. Elegant, minimal, and low-maintenance, our glass combines lasting beauty with functional design. With a little care, your table or vase will retain its distinctive charm for years to come

Materials Description

Our painted glass is created by applying pigment to the inner surface of the glass, a process that preserves the smooth clarity of the outer layer while enriching the material with depth and character. Though visually and tactilely identical to colored glass, the painted finish adds an artisanal dimension, with subtle variations that make each piece unique.

Durable yet refined, painted glass reflects light with the same purity and brilliance as coloured glass, offering a timeless surface that balances precision, craftsmanship, and contemporary expression.
