The subtle division between seat and backrest creates an almost floating effect, adding lightness to the sculptural form. Its geometric clarity brings a refined architectural presence to the dining table, while the open, inviting shape encourages comfort and social connection during meals.

Constructed with carefully layered foam and gently rounded edges, the Daiku Dining Chair balances structural precision with soft tactile appeal. Minimal visible stitching reinforces its sleek, minimalist character.

Upholstered in a 100% wool velvet, the fabric brings a richly textured surface that shifts gently with the light, creating subtle depth and movement. Soft and inviting to the touch, it combines natural warmth and resilience with a refined character suited to both private interiors and high-use environments.

In Desert, a soft sandy brown with golden and beige undertones, it speaks softly of sun-baked clay, weathered stone, and the light beige dust of long-traveled paths. Warm and grounding, it holds the stillness of wide skies and the slow rhythm of heat and wind moving across the land.

Together, they craft design that transcends time, poetic yet practical, expressive yet enduring.



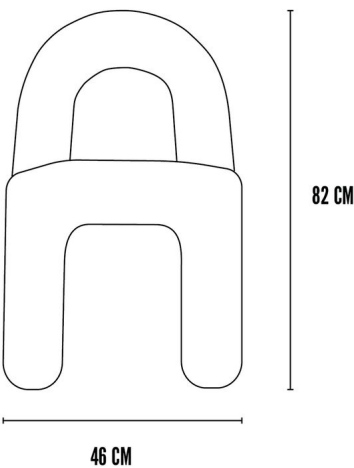
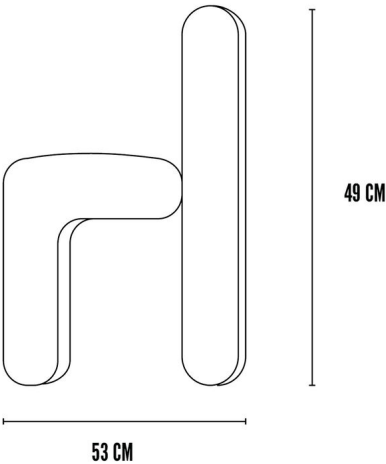

Family Description Text

The Daiku Collection emerges from an architectural rhythm, where stacked volumes and modular structures become furniture. Each piece is composed of two interlocking forms, the seat and the backrest, that remain distinct yet inseparably whole.

Geometric and cube like, the silhouettes hold a sculptural gravity, yet their openness invites ease, comfort, and exchange. The subtle separation of planes suggests lightness, as though the pieces hover in space, firm yet fluid, precise yet welcoming.

Softened by rounded edges and refined by restraint, Daiku embodies balance, structural clarity tempered by human touch. The minimized use of detail amplifies its monolithic calm, allowing form alone to speak.

Together, the Daiku Collection carries a quiet presence, architecture translated into places of rest and gathering.

Color Description

Desert is the quiet warmth of sunlit earth. It rests in a soft, sandy brown with gentle golden and beige undertones, like wind-shaped dunes and pale soil warmed by endless light. The color carries the calm of open landscapes, where the air shimmers and the horizon stretches far beyond the eye.

It speaks softly of sun-baked clay, weathered stone, and the light beige dust of long-traveled paths. Warm and grounding, Desert holds the stillness of wide skies and the slow rhythm of heat and wind moving across the land

Maintenance Guide Description

Velvet adds softness, depth, and elegance to furniture, and with gentle care it will maintain its rich appearance for many years. To keep the fabric looking fresh, lightly brush the surface with a soft upholstery brush or cloth in the direction of the pile. This helps maintain the velvet's natural sheen and prevents the fibers from flattening.

Dust can be removed with a vacuum cleaner using a soft brush attachment on a low setting. In case of spills, act quickly and gently blot the area with a clean cloth. Avoid rubbing, as this can push the stain deeper into the fibers. Minor marks can often be treated with a slightly damp cloth and left to air dry naturally.

Pressure marks from use can be softened by lightly steaming the fabric from a distance and gently brushing the fibers back into place once dry. To preserve the color and texture, keep velvet furniture away from prolonged direct sunlight and rotate cushions occasionally to ensure even wear.

Its dense pile creates a smooth, velvety surface that shifts gently with the light, giving the material a sense of depth and movement. When touched, the fabric feels soft and inviting, while the natural qualities of wool add warmth, resilience, and a refined character.

The surface catches and reflects light differently depending on the direction of the pile, creating subtle variations that enhance the richness of the color. Despite its soft and refined feel, the fabric is strong and highly durable, making it well suited for furniture in both private interiors and high use environments such as hotels, lounges, and public spaces.
