SAFETY

ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION

Check the contents to be sure everything is included. Before starting the installation, disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breaker or by removing the appropriate fuse at the fuse box. Turning the power off using the light switch is not sufficient to prevent electrical shock.

All electrical connections must be in accordance with local standards. Installation of the fixtures should only be done by an authorized electrician in accordance with the installation instructions and sector specific safety requirements. Any repairs of service and maintenance must be done by a person with the appropriate qualifications and who has read these guidelines. Any work carried out on the lighting fixtures should be performed only when the circuit is disconnected. During service and maintenance or remedial work, care should be taken to examine the mechanical status of the fixture fixings. It is prohibited to install the fixture to any light sources other than those specified on the product label. Failure to comply with this may result in product failure, jeopardize the electrical the electrical installation, or pose a risk to health and safety.

IT IS FORBIDDEN TO:

- Install the lighting fixtures to a power supply outside the parameters specified on the product label.
- Install the lighting fixtures in environments inconsistent with the stated degree of ingress protection (IP rating).
- Install the lighting fixtures with distance smaller to the illuminated object than specified on the product label.
- Install the lighting fixtures on a surface or structure other than is recommended by the manufacturer.
- Apply either mechanical elements or adapt the electrical installation procedure other than included in the instruction for use manual. Painted surfaces should always be cleaned with a soft damp cloth with the power disconnected. It is inadvisable to use chemically aggressive or solvent based cleaning agents. On culmination of their commercial life, the lighting fixtures should not be haphazardly discarded. They must be disposed of according to the WEEE Directive regulations either to a waste disposal point or returned to the manufacturer.

Polish using soft cloth.

To clean the glass shade use suitable glass cleaner.

Always use fabric gloves to protect the surface against damage.




ADJUSTING THE CABLE LENGTH


You can adjust the length of the cable if needed. Slide down the entire canopy (1) by untightening the metal nut in the brass ball (2) using a hex key. Unscrew and push the cable grip (3) to release the cable (4) from the inner construction (5) as explained in the picture.

Adjust the cord length. Place a thin electrician tape (6) to the place where you intend to cut to prevent the textile coating from moving. Then cut the cord and strip the wires. Remove the plastic layer from the exposed part of the steel cord (4).







NOTE

The textile coating of the cable is sensitive to abrasion. Always slide ceiling canopy and nut down carefully.




Be very careful not to damage the glass.

INSTALLING THE CEILING HOOK






Then connect the wires to the junction box (10), respecting the colours:
