

## Safety instructions

Important! Before commencing installation work disconnect the main cable from the power supply – remove fuse or turn switch to “OFF”!

1. Installation should be carried out in accordance with the local safety regulations.
2. In order to prevent damage, please check walls for cables before drilling holes.
3. Please ensure that all electrical connections (even preassembled lamps) are screwed tightly or are fully inserted as good contact is essential for a long life-span at high currents. Please check for tight connections after changing or adjusting lamps. Screwed connections must be tightened after 20 minutes.
4. Please do not place objects on your system (e.g. for decorative purposes) if they were not delivered with the system.
5. The lamps get very hot when in use. Please allow lamps to cool down before touching.
6. Do not change lamps or spots when switched on.
7. System should not be enlarged with additional lamps.
8. Use of a dimmer is highly recommended. Dimmer must be compatible with type of bulb.
9. To avoid greasy fingerprints it is recommended to wear white cotton gloves when handling visible metal and glass parts.
10. For lamps supplied with an external cable. If the external flexible cable or cord of this luminaire is damaged, it shall be exclusively replaced by the manufacturer or his service agent or a similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
11. The glass used for this lamp is hand-blown. Only 1st. quality has been chosen. Air bubbles and variations in thickness and colour is normal.
12. We reserve the right to make technical alterations.

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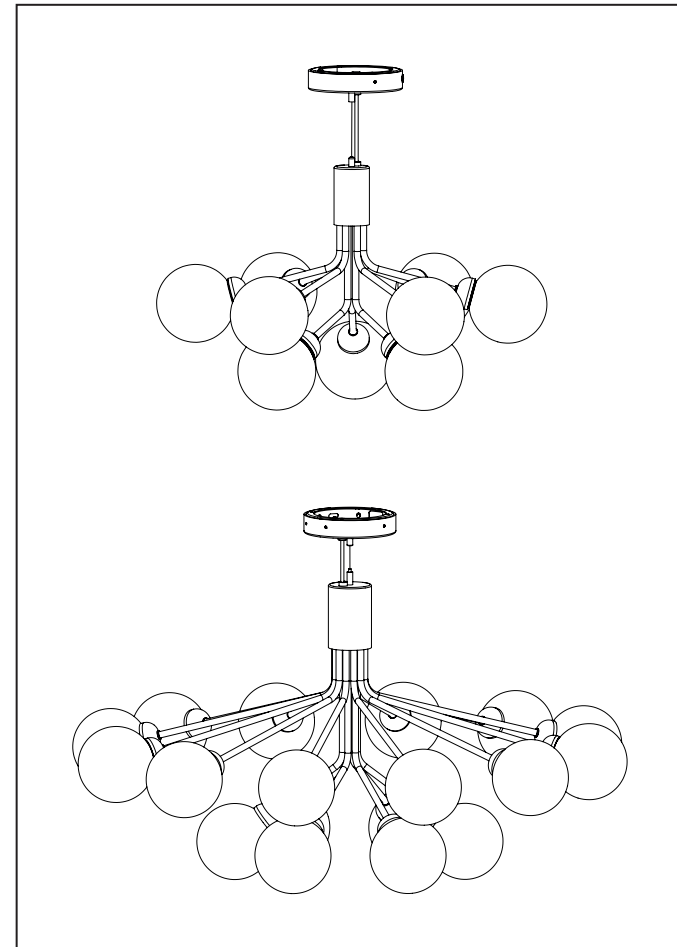
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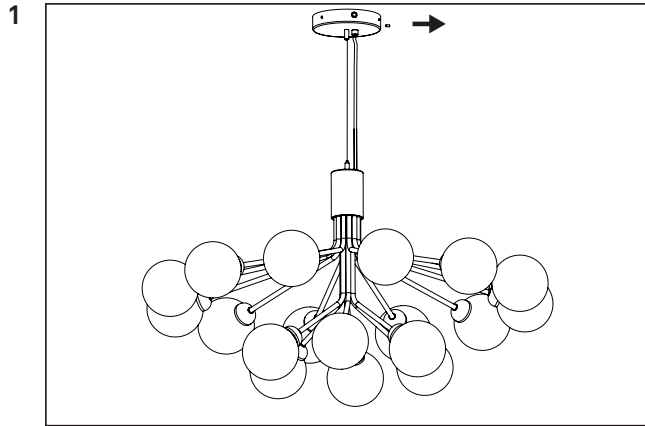
## Apiales 9 + 18 Cable Change

### Replacement Guide



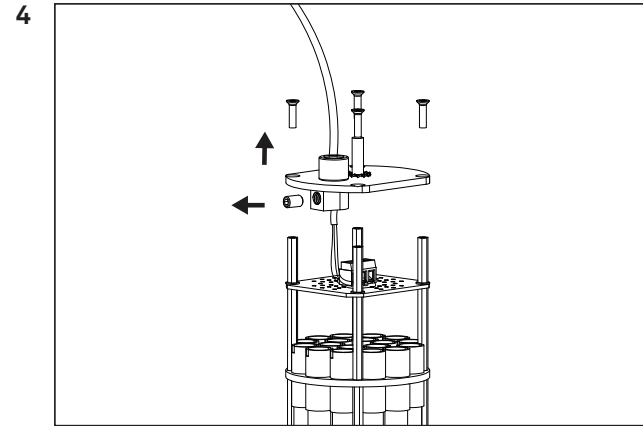
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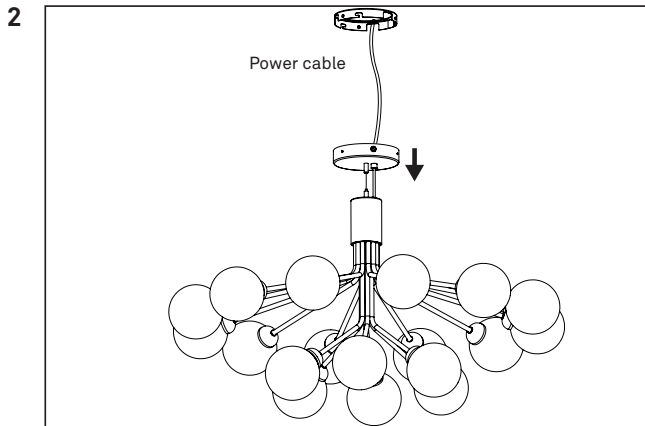
**Caution: Remember to turn off the power supply.**

Unscrew the set screw in the canopy. **Do not discard the screw.**



After removing the suspension cover, detach the top plate by unscrewing the 4 bolts.

Then remove the strain relief screw.

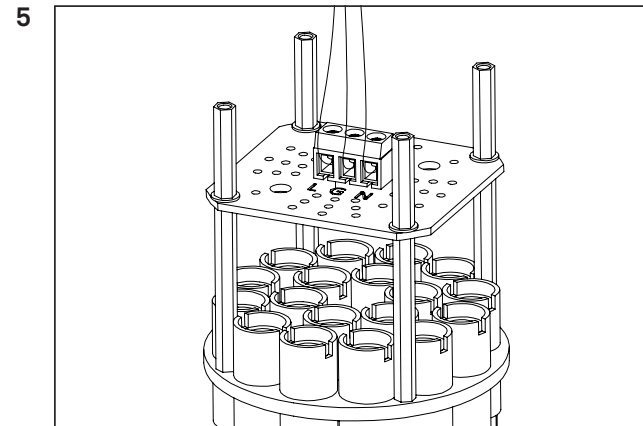


**Note that the lamp is supported by this part. Ensure the lamp is properly supported to prevent damage.**

Once supported, remove the cover by twisting and pulling it downward.

Unplug the wires from the power supply.

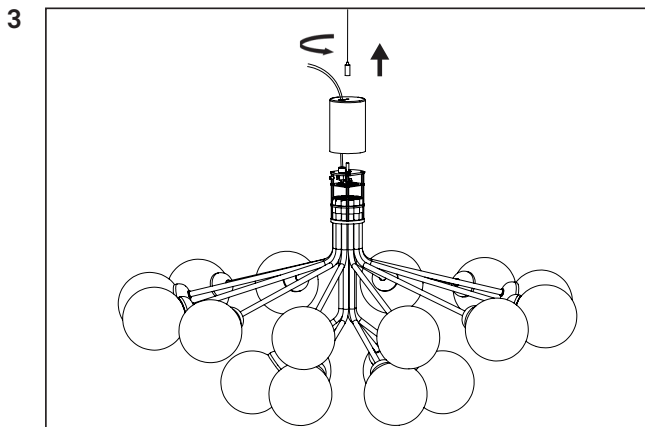
Loosen the strain relief to release the cable, and pull it out of the canopy.



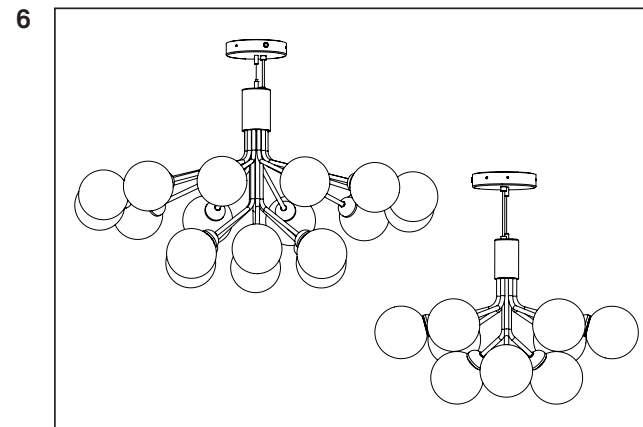
Disconnect the L (Brown), N (Blue), and G (Green/Yellow) wires by loosening them at the cable connector.

**When inserting a new cable.**

Remember to connect the wires in the cable connector according to their color coding.



With the lamp securely supported, remove the cover by loosening the wire grip located on top of the lamp.



Insert the new cable and reassemble all components in reverse order.
