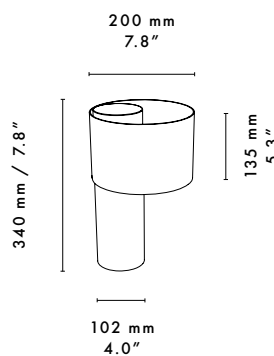

Det giver et rent og grafisk design. Toppen af det inderste rør er udført i opalglas, som elegant skjuler elpæren og samtidig skaber et blødt lys.
