THIJS PRINSEN - PRIMARY SHAPE

Thijs Prinsen's Primary Shape series of wall lights for Serax reinterpret a quintessential unit of construction—the brick—in surprising, delightful ways. Prinsen was inspired to make the Primary Shape series while working on a renovation that made extensive use of reclaimed brick. Influenced by both their rectangular form and reddish colour, his designs evolved to incorporate the cone and the cylinder, achieving a softer light with warmth and character.

Prinsen is the driving force behind Hasselt-based Lens°Ass Architects. Trained under Flemish master builder Marcel Smets, his lighting designs do not reclaim so much as rethink classic building materials. The clean, rectangular outlines of these lamps nod to the classic dimensions of bricks, while the cone and cylinder variations were created to meet a need for character ambient lighting. These distinctive designs come in two shades of concrete and terracotta, lending their elegant, understated shapes an earthy touch.
